Active members may borrow wine and beer making equipment




Then scroll down to the bottom of the page and press the Search button to see your results. You will get a list of members who match your criteria along with their contact information.




The Basics

To log in Click the Log in / Log Out button




Enter your email address and password and click LOG IN. Clicking the Remember me box will leave you logged in so you won't have to do it each time you visit. If you've forgotten your password, click the Forgot password link to receive an email with instructions on how to reset it.





To change your password


Once you are logged in you can change your password by clicking the login icon then the Change password link and filling out the information





To update your phone number, email or physical address

Click View Profile, then the Edit Profile button. Phone, email and address information is on the Profile tab. Click Edit Profile, make your changes then click Save



To update your privacy settings


Click the Privacy tab, then click Edit Profile. If you don't want any information shown to fellow club members uncheck the "Show profile to others" box (this will not remove access from system administrators). Or, you can select who can view each piece of your profile information by selecting the applicable button. Click Save when you are done.





To search the website

The website has a search function. To perform a search enter your search term into the box at the upper right that says "Enter search string" and hit enter/return on your keyboard. You will be returned a list of links where your search term appears.






Website Pages

Note: This is member only content. You must be logged in to see the information on the subpages. There is a wealth of valuable information in the Members section. Click any of the sub page for more information



We have forums for beer brewing and wine making, help needed and events happeing around town. Click a link to get to the forum you're interested in. Members are able to add postings to any forum.






Equipment may be reserved online. To do so, go to the Resources tab, then Club Equipment and click Equipment Calendar



You will be taken to a "view only" page where you can see the calendar showing which items are reserved. To reserve an item, click on the link that says "this form".




You will be taken to a form to fill out and submit your request. The form will be emailed to our Equipment Master for processing.
